Summer Camp Policies

Campers will not be allowed to attend camp until the supplemental applications are submitted. No Exceptions!

Drop-off and Pick-up:

Normal drop-off time is between 7:30 am and 8:00 am. Early drop-off is from 6:30 am and 7:30 am. Notification for early drop-off is required by 5 pm the day prior to the needed date.

Normal pick-up time is between 4:30 pm and 5:00 pm. Late pick-up is between 5 pm and 6:00 pm. Notification for late pick-up is required by 5 pm the day prior to the needed date.

Parents will be required to check campers in and out every day of camp. Only pre-arranged parents or guardians will be allowed to pick campers up. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Photo ID will be required at time of pick-up.

Early Drop-off and Late Pick-up Activities:

Campers being dropped-off early and being picked-up late will usually be in our carpeted and air-conditioned conference rooms. They will be allowed to play board games, cards, read, play our video games, watch TV or just relax. If they wish, they may be allowed to help camp counselors set up or put away camp materials used during of the day.

Illness:

Campers with a fever or illness should not attend camp. OTW does not have the ability to care for sick campers. OTW will not refund camp fees for days missed, but will at its discretion, make-up camp dates.

Medications:

Campers requiring medications need to have a parent check medications in and out each day of camp attendance. Parents need to make sure camp counselors are clear on dosages and times of use.

Acceptable and Unacceptable Behavior:

OTW Sports Camp should be a fun and enjoyable experience for all campers. OTWS will strive to help campers attain a spirit of friendly competition, cooperation, team spirit and camaraderie.

Unacceptable Behavior includes, but may not be limited to the following:

- Inappropriate vocabulary such as cursing or being sexually explicit.
- Demeaning language.
- Harassing or hazing other campers.
- Physical or verbal fighting.

- Taking or use of someone else's personal property without permission.
- Leaving the group without permission or proper escort.
- Disobeying safety rules

Discipline:

OTWS has no expectation of having discipline problems with campers. In the unlikely event of a problem, our procedure is as follows:

1. A look or gentle touch by counselor to show awareness/displeasure in activity of camper.
2. Counselor asking camper to stop activity.
3. Short time-out.
4. Longer time-out.
5. Camp director conference with camper.
6. Phone call to parent.
7. Camp director/parent/camper conference.
8. Short suspension.
9. Camp suspension.

Personal Items and Money:

Campers **should not** bring personal money to camp. Campers will not be allowed to play the air hockey or fussball games. The concession stand will not be open for the purchase of drinks or snacks. OTWS will provide drinks, snacks and lunch for campers. Air hockey and fussball will, on occasion, be played as a treat at OTWS expense.

Campers **should not** bring electronic games, toys, radios or cd players to camp. OTWS will not be responsible for personal belongings.

Clothing:

Campers will need to wear appropriate gym clothing. Daily attire should be shorts, shirt, socks, tennis shoes and a sweatshirt on cool days. A ball cap with a visor is recommended for outdoor activities. Sunscreen will be provided by OTWS. OTWS requires use of sunscreen. Campers with allergies to regular sunscreen should provide their own brand. OTWS will provide an OTWS camp shirt to all campers. It will not be required to wear camp shirts except during field trips. Campers who wish to play soccer in turf shoes or molded cleats still need tennis shoes every day.

A small bin will be provided by OTWS to hold reading book, ball cap, camp shirt and other acceptable personal belongings.

Swimming attire will be necessary periodically. 24 hour notification will be provided prior to going swimming.

Parent Attendance at Camp:

Parents are always welcome at camp without prior notice! If planning to attend during lunch, please try to let OTWS know ahead of time, so there is adequate food prepared. There will be a very nominal charge.

Birthdays:

Birthdays are special. OTWS will try to remember who is having a birthday during camp. Please try to help us with a gentle reminder! Birthday snacks are allowed during afternoon snack time, but only if there is enough for everyone. Please check with camp staff.

Reading:

OTWS feels encouraging reading is important both as an activity and also a break from strenuous play. Campers will have 20 minutes of reading after morning and afternoon snack times. Please spend some time with your camper in selecting age appropriate and interesting reading materials. For campers who forget, there will be materials in the OTW library. (The camp library will gladly accept additional reading materials and games, if they need a happy home.)
